## Repeat Back

A client recently shared a best practice observed while making field visits to project sites. During these field visits, a company required each person participating in the meet and greet with the client to “repeat back” one of the hazards discussed during their STA, or a new hazard altogether.

By doing this, the company was helping to ensure that all personnel were involved in the process and clearly understood the potential hazards associated with the task at hand.

This is a simple process and was immediately identified as a best practice that could be easily implemented by others. Our project managers and HSE professionals agree that crews are more at ease with their work when asked about hazards discussed during the STA.

Remember, with improved hazard awareness and improved communication of hazards, we can each make a lasting impact on Ref-Chem's safety culture.
